

Dress Code for Confirmation:

The dress code is intended to protect the dignity and modesty of the celebration of the Mass during Confirmation. It is essential that it be followed closely. Please realize that formal evening dress is not appropriate for a sacramental event.

YOUNG WOMEN:

Dresses or skirts and blouse (see sample pictures):

- *Must come to the knee, tea length, or longer*
- *Appropriate neck line (not lower than 1 inch below the collar bone)*
- *Back must be covered*
- *May not be sleeveless*
- *Shoulders must be covered*
- *Slips must be worn*
- *Dress shoes (May have a heel no more than 2 inches high)*



YOUNG MEN:

Dress Shirt and Tie

- *Button-down white or light color*
- *No polos or tee shirts*
- *Must have a collar*
- *Ties may have stripes, patterns or solid colors (no cartoons or words)*

Dress trousers

- *No baggy pants*
- *Trousers should be worn with a belt*
- *Dress shoes (school shoes are okay)*
- *Dress socks (not white sports socks)*

Sports Jacket

- *May be either a suit coat, sport coat, or blazer*
